

Installation instructions for TFF AR12 Pro Stock Adaptor



WARNING: It is a violation of Title 18 of the US Code, Chapter 44 section 922 (r) to install a folding or collapsible stock to an imported firearm without first ensuring that firearm is compliant to 922r. In the case of the Panzer AR12 you need at least 4 US made 922r compliant parts in the gun before adding folding or collapsible stocks.

18 U.S.C. § 922(r)

It shall be unlawful for any person to assemble from imported parts any semiautomatic rifle or any shotgun which is identical to any rifle or shotgun prohibited from importation under section 925(d)(3) of this chapter as not being particularly suitable for or readily adaptable to sporting purposes.

27 CFR 478.39 - ASSEMBLY OF NON-SPORTING SHOTGUNS AND SEMIAUTOMATIC RIFLES FROM IMPORTED PARTS

(a) No person shall assemble a semiautomatic rifle or any shotgun using more than 10 of the imported parts listed in paragraph (c) of this section if the assembled firearm is prohibited from importation under section 925(d)(3) as not being particularly suitable for or readily adaptable to sporting purposes.

Make sure your firearm is safe and completely unloaded. Remove the OEM butt stock from the rear of the lower receiver. Replace with the TFF Stock Adapter. An additional washer may be needed due to the length of the original bolt. Tighten the bolt to the lower receiver.

You are now able to screw in a buffer tube of your choice and also able to reinstall the sling mounts on the stock adaptor. After installation of the buffer tube, a standard AR style stock can now be used.
